United Nations General Assembly Resolution 3379, adopted on 10 November 1975 by a vote of 72 to 35, "determine that Zionism is a form of racism and racial discrimination". This was a very telling moment regarding the United Nations ' — and the international community ' s — stance on Israel. Twenty-five states sponsored Resolution 3379, which “ determine[d] that Zionism is a form of racism and racial discrimination. ” Seventy-two states voted in favor, 32 abstained and 35 were against the motion.
